## **FLIGHT TRAINING PROGRAM OUTLINE**

(CARs 405.13)

### **PROGRAM NAME** **FLIGHT INSTRUCTOR RATING**

An applicant shall hold a Commercial or Airline Transport Pilot Licence prior to commencing training and have completed a minimum 20 hours instrument time (10 hours may be simulator)

### **KNOWLEDGE**

An applicant shall have a minimum of **25 hours ground school** instruction on the following subjects:

**Practical application of basic principles of learning and instructional technique**

**Preparation and use of lesson plans**

**Preparatory ground instruction**

**Pre-flight briefings**

**In-flight instruction**

**Post-flight debriefings**

**Theory of flight**

**Aircraft manuals and operating limitations**

**Presentation of pilot decision-making concepts**

**Use of Transport Canada publications**

### **WRITTEN EXAM**

Obtain a minimum of **70% on the AIRAF written exam**

### **EXPERIENCE**

An applicant shall complete the following minimum requirements:

**30 hours dual flight instruction** including a minimum of:

**5 hours instrument** (teaching instrument flight skills)

**Note: while not required by Transport Canada, the Calgary Flying Club may require students to complete solo practice as necessary to improve general flight skills**

### **SKILL**

An applicant shall successfully complete a **flight test** to the standard outlined in the Flight Test Standards-Flight Instructor Rating
