FLIGHT TRAINING PROGRAM OUTLINE

(CARs 405.13)

PROGRAM NAME **RECREATIONAL PILOT PERMIT**

AGE

An applicant shall be a minimum of **16 years old**

MEDICAL FITNESS

An applicant shall hold a **Category 4 Medical Certificate**

KNOWLEDGE

An applicant shall have sufficient knowledge in the following areas:

Air Law
Navigation
Meteorology
Aeronautics-General Knowledge

(Note: the Private Pilot Licence ground school is recommended by the Calgary Flying Club but is not required by Transport Canada)

WRITTEN EXAM

Obtain a minimum of **60% on the RPPAE or PPAER written exam**

EXPERIENCE

An applicant shall complete the following minimum requirements:

25 hours recreational pilot flight training including a minimum of:

15 hours dual instruction including:
2 hours cross-country

5 hours solo flight time

(The remainder of the flight experience requirement shall consist of either dual or solo flights as necessary)

SKILL

Within the 12 months preceding the date of application for the licence, an applicant shall successfully complete a **flight test** to the standard outlined in the Flight Test Standards-Recreational Pilot Permit

The RPP allows you to fly a single-engine aircraft (including ultra-light aeroplanes) with a maximum of four seats anywhere in Canada provided there is no more than one passenger on board and the flight is conducted in day VFR conditions.
